Prescribed Burn and Wildland Fire Training

This four-day course addresses the foundational skills universal to all wildland firefighters and introduces concepts related to fire behavior. Various activities will be used to reinforce these concepts. As part of the course, there will be a field exercises portion lasting approximately 4 hours. Students should dress for the weather. Students should complete ICS-100 and L-180 online prior to attending class. Links will be provided upon registration.

S-190 Basic Fire Behavior
